Romantic Choices

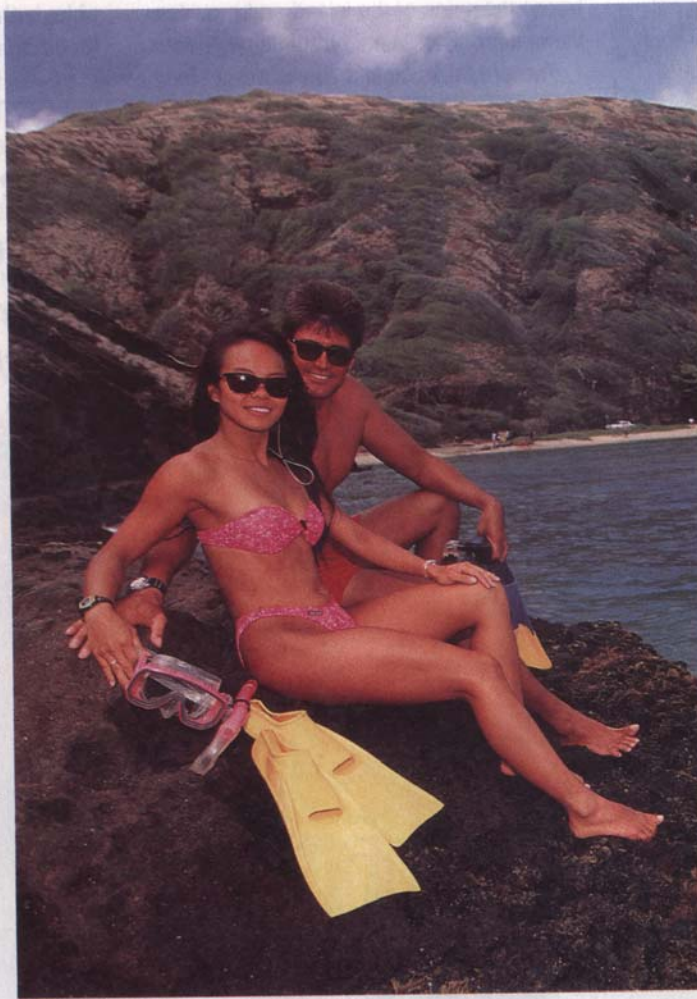
Packages provide a starting point for crafting romantic getaways
